

Code of Ethics of the Forum UNESCO Network

STIPULATIONS:

FIRST. To ensure that the articles of our constitution are upheld. These are given in the Agreement Protocol of Forum UNESCO's foundation, signed by the Director General of UNESCO and the Rector of the Polytechnic University of Valencia and President of Forum UNESCO.

SECOND. Undertake projects that promote the collaboration of universities most in need, through exchange programmes for students and teachers and the sharing of technology.

THIRD. Carry out the work pertaining to Forum UNESCO according to a disinterested and informal non profit-making collaboration.

FOURTH. Respect and disseminate the ideology of Forum UNESCO.

FIFTH. Encourage national and international conferences and meetings with a view to propagate the Forum UNESCO Network throughout the world.

SIXTH. Establish the necessary mechanisms to facilitate access to and integration in Forum UNESCO for any student interested in the safeguarding of heritage.

SEVENTH. Promote the development of programmes, field trips and other activities oriented towards further training for teachers and students in the area of heritage protection.

EIGHTH. Encourage contact with other public institutions and political and economic organisms with a view to improving the financial resources available for the completion of these objectives.
